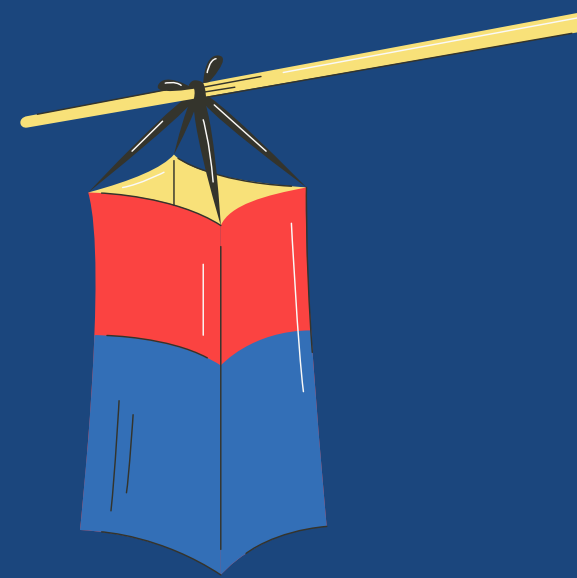

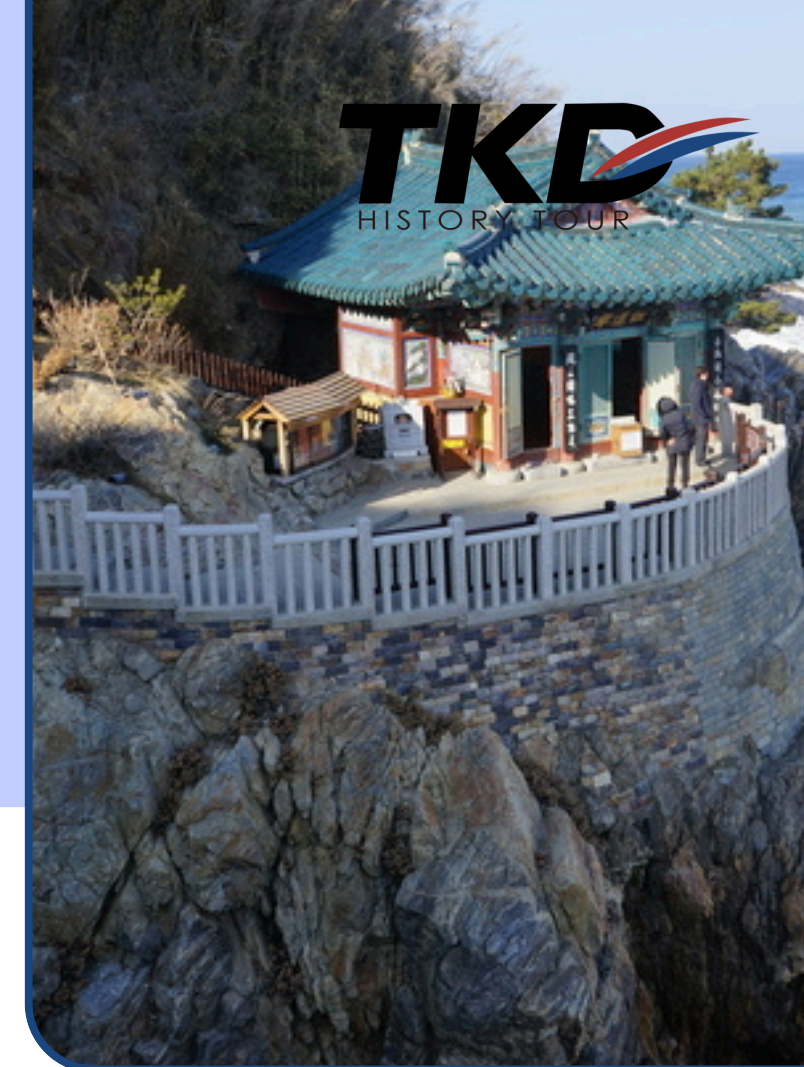

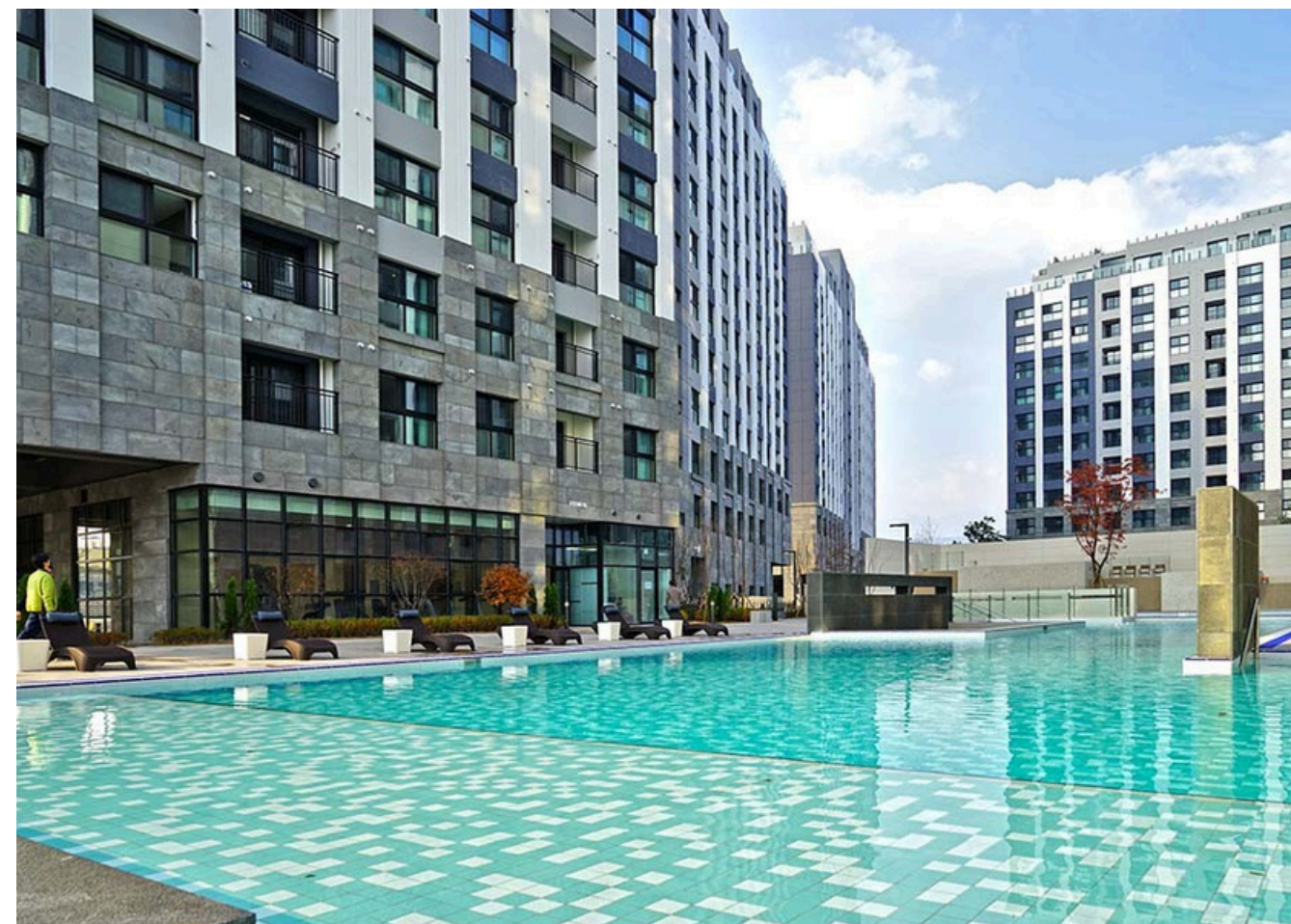
# Day 2
